## Scholarship For Summer Study In Scotland

### **Program**

The St. Andrew's Foundation of the Eastern Shore (<a href="https://www.sases.net/foundation">https://www.sases.net/foundation</a>), the 501(c)(3) non-profit arm of <a href="https://www.sases.net/foundation">The St. Andrew's Society of the Eastern Shore</a> (SASES), is offering a 3-week scholarship for Summer 2026 study at a Scottish university. Valued at \$9000, the scholarship will be awarded to a qualifying student from one of the eligible public or private high schools.

The Scholarship will cover the costs of tuition, room, and board. Excluded are international travel and incidental expenses.

After notice of award, the winning student may select from and apply to either or both of two well-established university-based Scottish summer programs. Information about both programs is available at the below website. Note, do NOT apply until notified of award:

- ISSOS at The University of St. Andrew's, or
- International Summer School for Teens at the University of Stirling

#### Applicants are expected to have:

- An interest in study abroad in general and in Scotland in particular
- A desire to experience its history and culture in an academic setting as well as during field trips.
- An overall GPA of 3.0 or above.
- Sophomore or junior year during the 2025/26 academic school year.

### To Apply

All applications materials must be submitted electronically by October 12, 2025. For Application Form, Application Guidelines and Selection criteria, a List of Eligible High Schools, The Parent Guardian Form, and other materials, see our website at: <a href="https://www.sases.net">www.sases.net</a> and click "Scholarships" on the top menu.

Application materials will be reviewed for completeness and quality. After the October 12 deadline, interviews will be will be conducted with the top-ranked students and a parent or guardian.

A scholarship will be awarded during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of November, 2025 to a primary candidate and one or more alternates without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, sex, or disability. Upon notification of award, the winner will be expected to apply immediately to one or both of the university programs in Scotland. The awardee will be expected to pay the application fee(s). SAFES will pay all program costs directly.
