Scholarship For Summer Study In Scotland

Program

The St. Andrew's Foundation of the Eastern Shore (<https://www.sases.net/foundation>), the 501(c)(3) non-profit arm of [The St. Andrew's Society of the Eastern Shore](#) (SASES), is offering a 3-week scholarship for Summer 2026 study at a Scottish university. Valued at \$9,000, the scholarship will be awarded to a qualifying student from one of the eligible public or private high schools.

The Scholarship will cover the costs of tuition, room, and board. Excluded are international travel and student incidental expenses.

After notice of award, the winning student may select from and apply to either or both of two well-established university-based Scottish summer programs. Information about both programs is available at the below website. Note, do NOT apply until notified of award:

Applicants are expected to have:

- An interest in study abroad in general and in Scotland in particular
- A desire to experience its history and culture in an academic setting as well as during field trips.
- An overall GPA of 3.0 or above.
- Sophomore or junior year during the 2025/26 academic school year.

To Apply

All applications materials must be submitted electronically by October 31, 2025. For Application Form, Application Guidelines and Selection criteria, a List of Eligible High Schools, The Parent Guardian Form, and other materials, see our website at: www.sases.net and click "Scholarships" on the top menu.

Application materials will be reviewed for completeness and quality. After the October 31 deadline, interviews will be conducted with the top-ranked students and a parent or guardian.

A finalist candidate will be notified of award mid-November, 2025. One or more alternates will also be notified that should the primary candidate not follow through, they will be next in line for an award. The scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, religion, national origin, sex, or disability. Upon notification of award, the winner will be expected to apply immediately to one or both of the university programs in Scotland. The awardee will be expected to pay the application fee(s). SASES will pay all program costs directly.
